<u>APPLICATION</u>: Once application approved, applicant will be notified by e-mail or telephone. Booths will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. No booths will be confirmed unless payment is received in full. You may e-mail your application, however, please mail the original application via regular mail. Certified or postage due mail will not be accepted.

<u>PAYMENT:</u> Payments may be made by check, money or credit cards (VISA, MC, AMX, DISCOVER). No post-dated checks will be accepted. **Returned checks will be assessed a \$35 service/processing fee. Payments made via charge card will be assessed a \$10 credit card processing fee.

<u>SECURITY DEPOSIT</u>: No security deposit will be charged at this time, however, should the Vendor violate the rules and regulations, Vendor will be charged \$100. It is our hope that everyone follows the rules and regulations.

<u>DEADLINE</u>: Postmarked before March 1, 2025. Booths will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. Once filled, no further applications will be accepted.

<u>DISPLAYS</u>: No tents, tent frames will be allowed on the main floor. Displays must be confined to your assigned space. There shall be no naiing, stapling, painting, pinning of Nani Maui equipment or rental equipment materials, including walls, tables, chairs, stages, floors etc.

SELLING FOOD ITEMS: If you are selling food items for consumption, you must obtain a permit from the State Department of Health and submit a copy with your application. You must have the original permit in your booth at the Fair. For further information contact the Health Department at (808) 933-0917. Sampling from booths is allowed, however, please keep your areas clean. If you are serving **any** food or drink samples, you must provide adequate trash receptacles to accommodate the additional trash.

INSURANCE: You should contact your insurance company and ask them for a rider to your public liability policy, property damage and burglar insurance policies covering you during and at the show. You are merchandise. Hawaii Arts & Crafts will not be liable for lost or stolen merchandise, products or equipment.

<u>ELECTRICITY IS AVAILABLE IN LIMITED AREAS:</u> Rental Fee \$25 per day (totaling \$78.19). You must bring your own surge protectors, electrical cords, and painter's tape. Please use low wattage bulbs for lighting.

<u>TABLES/CHAIRS:</u> Rental Fee for Tables \$30 per day (totaling \$90.75 for three days). Table size feet. Chairs \$10 per day (totaling \$31.per chair for three days). All tables must fit within your booth space, allowing access to your booth.

<u>DOOR PRIZES</u>: All vendors are required to donate at least one item or gift certificate for drawings. Prizes will be announced throughout the fair. Please complete the donation form in the packet and turn it in with our application. You may copy the door prize form if you wish to donate more than one item and receive free promotional advertising at the Fair. DO NOT send in or turn in your item at any time. Winners will be required to pick their prize directly from you at your booth.

<u>SECURITY:</u> The building will be secured at 5:00 pm until the next morning at 8 am on Thursday and Friday. Vendors may leave their booth set up overnight but be sure to secure or remove your merchandise and valuables. You leave your merchandise at your own risk. We will not be responsible for any damaged, stolen or missing items.

<u>SET UP:</u> April 23, 2025 2:00 P.M. – 5:00 P.M. on Wednesday. Entrance and Exit for vendors through designated side entrance only. Vendors will be allowed into the building at 8:00 A.M. for all three days of the fair.

- Vendor has deposited a nonretundable Booth Fee to reserve a booth space at the Fair to display and sell their merchandise.
- HAAC is not charging a security deposit at this time, however, should the Vendor violate the rules and regulations, Vendor will be charged \$100 and/or pursue other remedies, whether at law or in equity.
- HAAC has the right to assign the location and size of the Vendor's booth.

 Booth will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. The applicant has a greater chance of obtaining their preferred booth space if a properly completed application form is submitted early. An incomplete application may be delayed in process.

Vendors shall decorate assigned area in conformity to standards set by HAC, which may, at its discretion direct and limit Crafter regarding decoration and use of display signs, materials, and equipment.
 Vendor must have booth completed and display set at the times designated. Vendor is responsible for the

clean-up of his/her area and the removal of all items brought to the Fair.

- Vendor shall defend, indemnify and hold Nani Mau Gardens, Hawaii Arts & Crafts, LLC, their officers and employees, subcontractors, agents or volunteers harmless from and against any all claim and action for personal injury, death or property damage arising from or resulting from or in any way of the Vendor's concession, including claims by Vendor's employees, heirs, representatives, successors against Hawaii Arts and Crafts, LLC and Nani Mau Gardens. HAAC will not be held responsible or held liable for theft, damage, loss of merchandise, product, or equipment.
- Vendor should contact their insurance company and ask the operation should ask them for a rider to your public liability policy, property damage and burglar insurance policies covering you during and at the show. You are responsible for yourself and your merchandise.
- HAAC will not be responsible for lack of sales, protection from weather or natural causes.
- HAAC reserve the right to reschedule the Fair due to pandemic, war, natural disasters or any other reason.
- Vendor is personally liable for all taxes, whether excise, income or any other levy related to the income Vendor may derive from the Fair. Vendors will be responsible to have a current GE License available in their booth. This agreement shall not be construed as a joint venture or partnership between the Vendor and HAAC.
- This agreement cannot be assigned or otherwise transferred by either party without written consent obtained from the other party. No change, alteration, modification, or addition to this agreement shall be effective unless in writing and properly executed by the parties. The agreement shall be binding on the parties hereto and their assigns, representatives, heirs, and successors.
- Vendor agrees to abide by all the rules and regulations of the Fair and to conduct themselves in accordance with these rules and regulations of HAAC, which includes No shows, late arrivals, and early departures. Booths must be kept open until the end of the Fair. Absolutely no soliciting of vendors for other events allowed. All handouts distributed must be approved by HAAC.
- In the event there is a breach of any of the rules of this agreement on the par;t of the Vendor, HAAC has the right to remove the Vendor from the Fair, remove any unauthorized items being sold, charge \$100.00 and pursue any other remedies, whether at law or inequity.
- HAAC reserves the right to revoke the privilege of admission to the Fair of any Vendor, whereupon the booth space fee will be returned. HAAC reserves the right to refuse any application for admission for any reason.
- Vendor allows HAAC to take photographs of vendor and their products for documentation and promotional purposes.


Aloha Crafters, Vendors & Visitors:




